Norovirus

Norovirus was the 2nd leading cause of outbreaks in untreated recreational water, such as lakes, from 1978-2010. It can live in water for several months or possibly even years. Swimming venues that are not treated with chlorine can pose a particular risk since there are no chemicals to kill the stomach virus. Swimmers can help protect themselves, their families and friends from the norovirus by following a few easy and effective steps:

- Keep the pee, poop, sweat, and dirt out of the water
- Don't swim if you have diarrhea or have been vomiting
- Shower before you get in the water *Don't pee or poop in the water
- Don't swallow lake or pool water
- Every hour—everyone out!
- Take kids on bathroom breaks
- Check diapers, and change them in a bathroom or diaper-changing area—to keep germs away from the water
