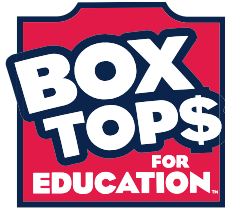

- Select 'Create an Account.'
- Continue with Google or fill out your Name, Email Address and create a Password.
- Select 'Add my current VIP card' or 'Create a new V.I.P. Card.'
- Enter your Fry's V.I.P Card Number or create a new V.I.P. card number. Then select 'Create Account.'
- It will prompt you to the 'Leave Page,' which will take you to www.frysfood.com.
- Continue to step #2 to register for Fry's Community Rewards Program.

STEP 2: REGISTER FOR THE FRY'S COMMUNITY REWARDS PROGRAM

- If at www.frysfood.com, scroll to the bottom click, Fry's Community Rewards – you are already signed in.
 1. If you skipped Step 1, go to www.FrysCommunityRewards.com
 2. Select 'Sign-In'.
 3. Sign in with Google or enter your email and password then select 'sign in'.
 4. Select 'Enroll Now'
 5. Under 'Find Your Organization: Enter **AmeriSchools Academy – Tucson Campus** or our number (**GD980**) before clicking on search make sure the description is selected (example: Education, Faith Based, Animal, Athletic, or **All**) on the View By Type.
 6. Then select 'Search'.
 7. Once you have found us click 'Enroll'

If you have registered correctly, you will see a confirmation page stating 'You have successfully enrolled in Community Rewards
