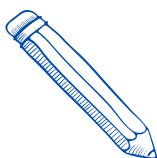
Reminders

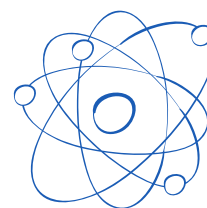

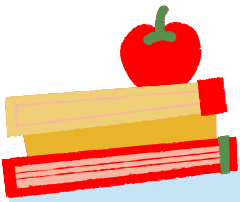
