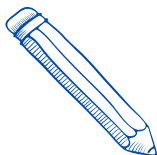
Glow Party

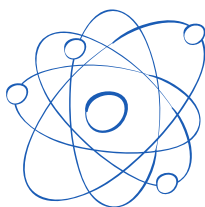
