A letter from our Principal

Dear AmeriSchools Families,

Thank you for a great start to the school year! We will continue to challenge our students academically and provide many opportunities for enrichment through after-school activities and community explorations. Clubs should start sometime this month. Please be on the lookout for notices going home regarding what day/time your child is in a club.

We are already seeing some colds going around. If your child is sick, please remember to keep them at home for the safety of others. If they need to work from home, please contact their teacher. If you do take your child to the doctor, please remember to get a doctor's note and submit it to the front office so we can excuse the absence. Please be aware that even if an absence is excused it still counts in the state's 10% allowed for the school year. If your child will be out more than a day or two let us know so we can try and make arrangements for them to work at home. Most importantly we need to have communication between home and school, so we know how to help.

All clubs ended earlier in December. If your child wants to join a club for next semester, they must sign up. If your child was in a club this past semester, that does not mean they will be in the same one next semester. They must fill out the forms that will go home later in January, return it, and be selected.

As a reminder, if there are any outstanding balances on their account, they will not be eligible to participate in clubs. Please keep all fees up to date. Until clubs resume, we expect the traffic to get a little heavier during pick-up. Please remember to obey all traffic laws. This is for the safety of the children. If you have a child at each dismissal time, then it is best to wait for the second dismissal before getting in the pickup lane. We do appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

- Go to SchoolMint Connect and create an account if you don't have one.
- Log in and click "Re-Enroll" next to your child's name.
- Follow the prompts and submit.

You'll get a confirmation email once done. YAY!!! Please contact our office if you need any additional help.

Before and after care and preschool: Capstone Quest Academy

Our before and after school and preschool program is available from 7 a.m. until 6 p.m. We have weekly rates and a Thursday rate for before and after-school care. For preschool, we have weekly rates with two different time slots 8 am-3:30 pm or 7 am-6 pm. We are DES-certified if you need assistance with the payment. A contract is required before your child can stay; payment must be made each Monday.

Lunches:

All lunch orders are due on Thursdays at 2:00 p.m. for the following week. These can be paid for in the classroom or the office.

Fees:

Please keep all before and after-school care, preschool, and supply fees up to date. Also, there are still some activity fees that still need to be paid. This is a yearly fee of \$40 per student and \$20 for each additional sibling. This goes to buy supplies for art, music, PE, and after-school clubs. A supply fee can be paid instead of buying the items from the school supply list. This fee is \$60 per student/per year and should be paid before the first day of school. Please contact the school office if payment arrangements must be made. All fees must be current for your child to participate in clubs.

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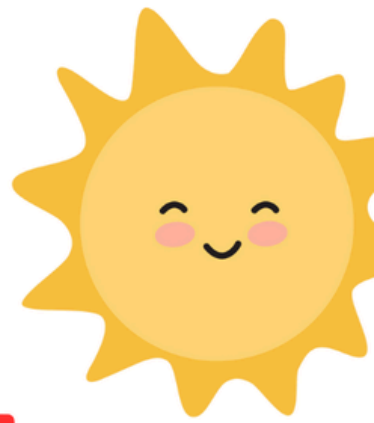
