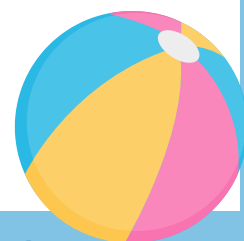

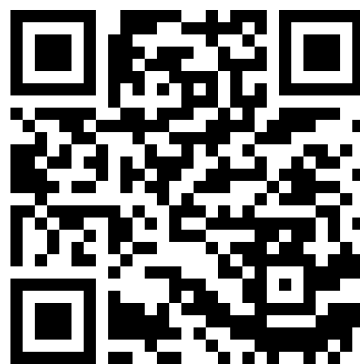

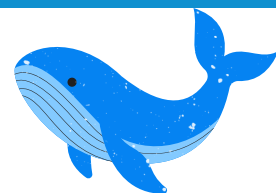
6th level Promotion Dance. Come join your promoting class and friends in the last dance of the year. Only for current 6th level students. Music, food and fun.

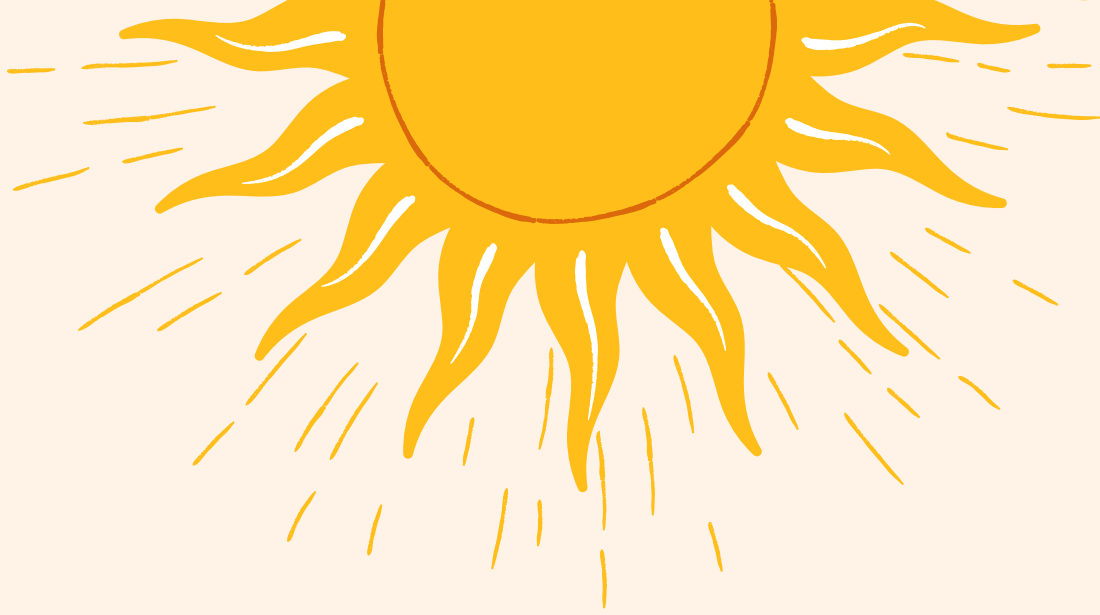

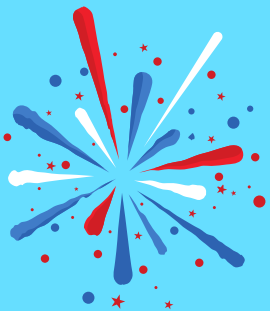
